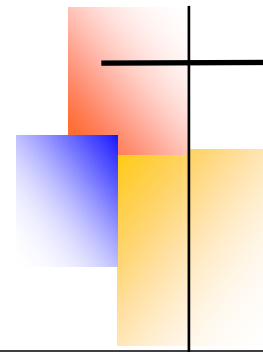

The Wonder and Challenge of Revelation

Today is Trinity Sunday when we can reflect once again on a fundamental but difficult idea that is the triune God. Theologians have come up with a variety of ways to understand or make sense of what we believe scripture teaches, that is one God, three Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. One thought pioneered by Karl Barth looks at God through the lens of revelation. The Father reveals the Son to the world through the Holy Spirit. Only God can help us know God so Jesus as both fully human and fully divine can reveal to us God the Father and it's by the Holy Spirit we know God the Son and God the Father.

Today at the AGM we will talk about some difficult matters and challenges but the foundational goal in my thinking is that we want people to come to know Jesus Christ, and to know our heavenly Father by means of the Holy Spirit. This is a sacred task about which we need to be intentional, seeking to reach out to all who want to hear more about Jesus and beyond. God through his Spirit is calling people into relationship with him in a variety of ways depending on their circumstances, but most of all through those who have the courage to openly speak graciously and honestly about Jesus and the hope and joy they have in him.

It also means being intentional about seeing one another grow in Christ, in our love for him, for one another and those around us and in our knowledge of the truth so we can do his will. Such love and honesty is practical, faithful, courageous and watchful. How easy it is to be asleep in the light, distracted or preoccupied with our own worries and concerns so that those moments and opportunities that come pass us by. We have, in Christ, the gift of eternal life. Let's spread that gift around with God's help.
