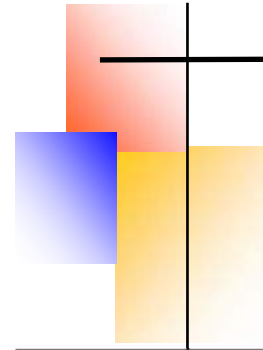

A QUESTION OF PRIORITIES

This weekend people from across the Diocese gather for Synod. What will come forth for discussion and consideration, especially given recent events, is not clear yet. The motions already presented are straightforward, some relating to the procedures and functioning of the Dioceses, others being what we might call 'motherhood' motions commenting on one social issue or another.

Most professions include professional development, conferences, board meetings and so on. We joke about the little they seem to achieve or how they serve to be time wasters or we get frustrated by personal agendas or self-indulgent politics. Churches and church organisations are no exception.

Today's gospel reading is an important reminder that Synod's fundamental task is to promote the proclamation of the gospel of Jesus Christ in word and deed, the gospel that changes and transforms lives like that of the blind man and Zaccheus. It's about faith, love and hope working themselves out amongst God's people through the Holy Spirit in the name of Christ. It's this priority that can lay the foundation for any gathering of Christians to make a difference for the glory of God.
