For years prayer has been encouraged at KAC in a number of ways. At present they include the prayer diary, our prayer cycle praying for 3 families or people each week, the prayer chain, prayer ministry after the service and the weekly prayer meeting/time. They are ways by which we express our dependence upon God and our care for each other. Occasionally there are times in a serious situation when we have organized prayer fasts or organised a church-wide call to prayer.

As we consider our prayer life there are three things that come to my mind. Firstly are we, are you praying, praying for mission, for the community, and the members of KAC? It's too easy to get busy and not pray at all. Secondly, prayer at its best is mutual. Do we do what most end up doing, praying for our own needs, for those close to us and little more, or do we pray beyond that small circle? It's a great blessing to know complete strangers praying for us because of our links in Christ as we found with BCA. Finally, as we pray are we respecting the confidentiality of one another and others, especially when we ask members to pray for others besides ourselves? We can no longer assume 'I will pray for you' is a request that will always receive a 'yes'. Prayer is a gift to be given and received freely.
