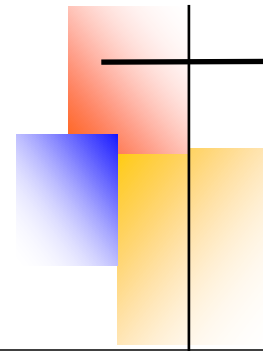

TALKING TO GOD!

As we continue looking at the creeds, in particular the Nicene Creed, we also start this next month focusing on prayer for the growth of the church and especially our church. The creeds remind us of our God on whom we depend. The creeds though are not simply compositions we occasionally recite in church for the sake of it. As we look at a month of prayer, they speak to us of how our God Father, Son and Spirit relate to us in prayer.

The creeds remind us of the Father who made us, who is the foundation for prayer by which for our part we acknowledge his love and sovereignty. He is the Father who sustains and loves us as part of his creation and as bearers of his image. He provides all the resources we need and in prayer we come to him to access all we need to live as his children.

The creeds also speak of the Son who is our motivation for prayer because he saved us and made the way for us. Through Christ we are able to call his Father our Father as adopted children and bring all to him. Much that is his by right becomes ours by adoption. His life is our life, his sacrifice is our redemption and his love for us moves us to love others. He is our great High Priest who stands with us and stands before and with the Father.

Thirdly they remind us that it is the Holy Spirit who is the power of prayer, who draws us up into the heavenlies and empowers us as he did Christ. In the Spirit we can call and know God as Abba, Father. We can know his love and mercy and life personally and as his people. We prayerfully depend upon him to live lives of love and holiness and he dwells in us, walking with us, enabling us to pray even when groans are all we can manage. We do not pray alone but rather in Christ can approach God with confidence and hope.

COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- * Masks no longer mandatory while indoors at church but if you for any reason prefer to still wear one please do so. That is simply a matter of choice.
- * Hospitals and Residential aged care and disability care facilities -
 - Masks must still be worn
 - two visitors per patient per day (except for compassionate reasons and essential visitors)
 - Visitors still required to show proof of vaccination

- * Be mindful during the greeting of the peace of other's preferences especially if they prefer not to make physical contact with others.
- * The collection at both services will happen by means of placing one's gift in the basket up front.

- * Keep alert for state government requirements.
