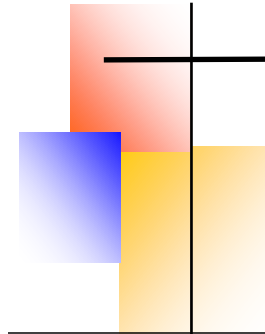

The Cross - Restored and Reunited

One of the deeper heartbreaks we can experience as human beings is to be involved in the breakdown of a significant relationship in some way. On a larger scale, we have seen and see communities and nations divided as differences spill over into payback and violence. All too often we build walls rather than bridges! Sometimes those differences really matter and cannot be easily reconciled. Such is the breakdown of our relationship with God as sin and unrighteousness rend our relationship with God asunder.

Into this mire, we consider today the wonder of Cross as God works to reconcile the world to himself. God reaches out to us in Christ even as we pull away and resist the all-embracing love of God. God's love is seen in his taking the initiative to reach out to us, to make the first step in reconciling his image-bearers who rejected their maker to himself. The power of sin that enslaves us and the just judgment of God that would extinguish us is dealt with by Christ on the Cross as he lays down his life for us, the innocent in place of the guilty. God comes as one of us to make the way.

As we think about what God has done for us in his beloved Son we also see a model for us in the face of disagreement, conflict and division. Being recipients of the gospel means we too can be peacemakers and agents of reconciliation. This is no easy task and sadly there are times where such a task is not possible in the short-term but there are so many stories like the prodigal son that speak to us of the powerful, reconciling love of God.
