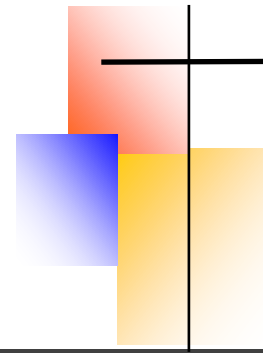

## Is Justice in the Eye of the Beholder?

The authoress Margaret Hungerford coined a phrase in her novel Molly Bawn we've all used: 'Beauty is in the Eye of the Beholder'. The sentiment has been around much longer, whether in Shakespeare's 'Love's Labour Lost' or even earlier. As we look at the book of Amos in light of 2 Kings, we may well ask if justice is in the eye of the beholder as well?

Such a question though beggars a deeper question: What is one's definition of justice and why? This issue is becoming more pressing in the Western world that is post-modern and politically correct. Everyone's freedom to choose is to be respected on the one hand but woke culture and social media lead to a new wave of self-righteousness, trial by media, shaming and coercion. Meaningful and generous dialogue between differing points of view has become all but non-existent yet various groups cry out for justice on the basis of their real or perceived oppression and suffering. On the one hand we all want to see justice done, fairly and even-handedly for all yet the subtext appears to be that some groups are more deserving of justice than others.

The scriptures speak loudly of justice, especially the Prophets for the oppressed, for the poor and vulnerable and needy whoever they may be, but its foundation of what justice is lies in the very nature of God, his will for us and his relationship with us. For as long as we seek to define justice on our terms without regard for God, the exercise will always be flawed and unjust. Justice risks becoming the purview of the rich, influential and privileged or the will of the mob. For us, justice lies in God, is modelled in Jesus and lived amongst each other as his people as we live as salt and light in the world. This is a part of our calling and life as the church.
