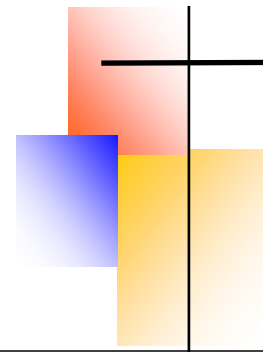

LOOKING FORWARD

At our AGM just over a month ago we discussed the challenge of the future of KAC and the church. Like many traditional churches we are struggling, especially in the aftermath of the ongoing pandemic. If we like all other churches are going to grow, it's because we are prayerfully making and growing disciples. At Parish council we discussed the matter further drawing on the 3 key features I outlined in my discussion paper as a church that is 1) Pastoral & relational, 2) Missional & Evangelistic and 3) Relevant and mindful with regard to our present culture and circumstances.

I will be taking some leave later this month and when I return it's time to concertedly address these issues. As to the first we will reactivate a pastoral care team, put more effort into sourcing life groups and look at how all of us can continue to be a welcoming and loving church. As to the second we will look again at having occasional but regular outreach events like the holiday club. There are courses on sharing one's faith that can be considered as well as hot potatoes. Testimonies are another feature we may well see more of. As to the third the first step is to reconsider our service times so that we are in a better position to reach out to people, especially younger folk who wrestle with Sunday Sport, atypical work schedules and so forth. There will be a sheet with options regarding service times and structures that will be available this weekend. I want people to talk about them over the next few weeks while I'm on leave with a view to making a decision so that any potential changes can be enacted soon and together. If our hope and goal is to see people come to and grow in Christ. What will we do, what will we lay aside and how can we be a clear light to Christ here in Karrinyup?
