

A Misquote, a True quote and Faithfulness

When we think of St Francis of Assisi we think of his famous prayer, those words that have been immortalized in song. We also think of the familiar words oft quoted:

'Preach the gospel at all times. And if necessary, use words.'

It's a misquote attributed to St Francis that never appeared in any of his writings or of those who wrote of his life soon after his death. The closest words to these come from his Rule of 1221, Chapter XII on how the Franciscans should practice their preaching:

No brother should preach contrary to the form and regulations of the holy Church nor unless he has been permitted by his minister ... All the Friars ... should preach by their deeds.

Another quote that is rightly attributed to Francis is the following:

It is no use walking anywhere to preach unless our walking is our preaching.

The fundamental truth St Francis nonetheless reminds us that reflects the teaching of the New Testament is that our words and actions ought to match up. When they don't we fall prey to, at best, weakness and, at worst, hypocrisy. True faith and love shows themselves in deeds, obedience and service. Peter reminds us that even when, especially when we suffer for our faith, this truth should continue to be evident as we model Christ and follow in his footsteps with heart, mind and hands for his glory with the help of the Holy Spirit.
