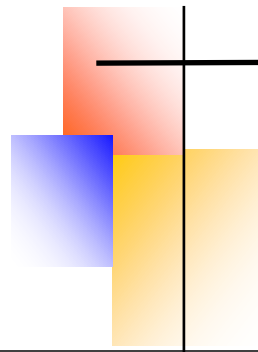

LIVING FOR GOD – LAW AND SPIRIT

Along with Abraham Moses is one of the most significant Old Testament figures. As we think about his birth and life and how it points forward to Jesus, we are looking at a man and his ministry that also reminds us of human weakness and why Jesus came.

Both of these men were called by God and were people whose lives and actions revealed God. Moses did so as the lawgiver and human mediator of the covenant and Jesus did so as the very Son of God. Both revealed to the world that the God Moses served and was Jesus' Father was also the holy God, dwelling in pure light, free of sin, transcendent and glorious. God as such was not able to fellowship with humanity as he did with Adam and Eve in the garden. We know even Moses was prone to a temper and self-doubt and experienced the brokenness we all struggle with.

God's overwhelming holiness is something few encountered up close and the experience was always overwhelming and life-changing whether Moses' encounter at the burning bush or Isaiah's vision in the temple or Ezekiel's by the river Chebar. Yet God through Moses and Christ makes the way for unholy people to know and live with the Holy God. Through Moses God gave the people the law and the cult, the priesthood, sacrifice and festivals. Through Christ God gives us the gift of eternal life through his death and resurrection.

As we come to Christmas and think of Moses and Jesus, who both mediated covenant with the Holy God for an unholy people, to bring life, we remember that in Christ the life we live is one by the Spirit, obedience not to a set of rules or rituals but from the heart by faith. It was this reality Moses looked forward to and we know in Jesus.
