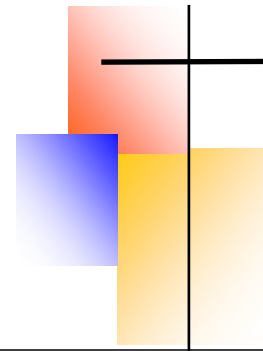

## FACING A CHALLENGE – P.R.A.Y.E.R.

Over the next three weeks I am doing a short series looking at the foundations for Christian ethics and how and why we are called to live as we are as Christians. The covenant relationship with God we enjoy with the triune God means a radical change in the way we live in every aspect of our life, in our relationships, sexuality, money, aspirations and so forth. I'm doing this because there appears to be a crisis in the Anglican and wider church as to what it means to live ethical, moral and holy lives as Christians, especially Christian leaders. In some quarters the prevailing ethic appears to be little more than be nice to people, show them some respect and do so with sincerity. This crisis is part of the challenges this Diocese faces and have resulted in the tensions within.

We also face a challenge as a parish in terms of our financial state. We have no reserves to draw upon anymore, nor help from outside groups and we are begging to creep into debt. The budget being presented is a hard one, but we have little choice. The challenge as ever is the challenge ultimately of growth and how we might grow as we live for Christ.

At times I find both these challenges all but overwhelming. In human terms they are obstacles that seem insurmountable so how do we proceed. We need simply to start praying or continue praying if we already are praying. We need to pray for revival, renewal and change for the better in the Diocese and Australian Anglican church. We need to pray individually about our giving and whether we can do more. If you can't, you can't but the question needs to be asked as to how much and how we give. Pray about how we can authentically be salt and light together for Christ and how we can reach out and see lives saved and changed for the Glory of God.

## COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- \* 2 sqm rule and 75% patron maximum capacity is removed
- \* Masks no longer mandatory while indoors at church but if you for any reason prefer to still wear one please do so. That is simply a matter of choice.
- \* Hospitals and Residential aged care and disability care facilities -
  - Masks must still be worn
  - two visitors per patient per day (except for compassionate reasons and essential visitors)
  - Visitors still required to show proof of vaccination
- \* Practice good hygiene at all times, on entering the building and before taking communion especially
- \* Be mindful during the greeting of the peace of other's preferences especially if they prefer not to make physical contact with others.
- \* The collection at both services will happen by means of placing one's gift in the basket up front.
- \* If anyone feels unwell or at risk, stay home and if need be get tested ASAP
- \* Keep alert for state government requirements.
