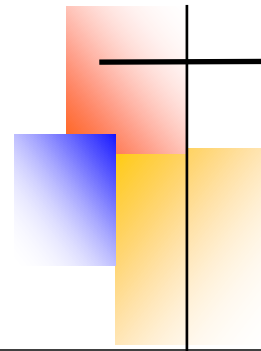

### UNSTOPPABLE GRACE

Over the last few years it has become apparent that the Anglican church in other parts of the world like North America are seemingly on the path to oblivion, disappearing in the next two decades barring a miracle. This last week I was quietly reminded Australia and the Anglican Church here in Perth and WA is no exception. It appears to be pretty hopeless but God is greater than our fears. So from where do we find hope, faith and courage to stand?

This week we look at the last of the main Old Testament history books that is 2 Kings. At first glance, aside from a few bright spots, the book appears to be pretty depressing as Israel and Judah become increasingly rebellious and it all comes to an end beginning with Assyria's invasion of Israel.

As we work through this book, the miracles, the intrigues, and the people on the road to exile keep your eyes open for those important signs of hope, faith and courage. It's easy today as it was then to see only the grey, or like Elijah to feel the despair as everything appears to go to pot. Then and now people craved power, glory, and wealth at the expense of others, especially the weak and vulnerable. Both then and now fickleness rather than faithfulness, selfishness rather than selflessness, lies rather than truth, foolishness rather than wisdom all appear to be the order of the day.

Yet God never completely abandoned his people and faith was never in vain even as it all fell apart. We need to remember God is still at work in the world, faith is not forgotten and hope not in vain because as evil abounds grace abounds all the more. It may not be obvious, but grace was there when Israel and Judah entered exile for a time and when God's Son died for us on the Cross. As we look at some substantial changes at Karrinyup, we trust God's grace is at work today.
