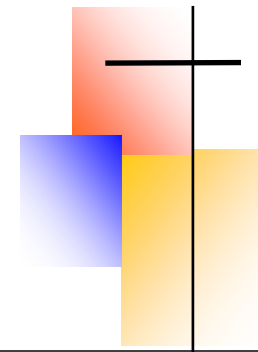

## A COVID UPDATE

Dear friends, as of Saturday the 5<sup>th</sup> of December the good news is that we are no longer required to socially distance. On the other hand we are now required, as are all businesses, to keep a record of attendance in one way or another. For the folk who come to 8.00am, we will keep a manual register where we record your name, phone number and time of arrival. If people would like to download the SafeWA app and use it they can but I understand such things can be a confusing exercise so don't feel obliged. We will keep a register for 9.30am as well but people can also book ahead using try booking. That information will be added to the manual register. You can also download the app and record your arrival using the QR Code we receive for the Parish. It will be printed up and taped to the front door and wall. You only need to do this once, when you arrive. For families with children who do NOT have their own phone, I suggest using the Trybooking option or access the manual register. I understand the app only works for the one person using their smart phone so you won't be able to register another person.

Otherwise directives regarding good hygiene still apply so we will keep up our store of hand gel for people to use as needed. Be mindful of others regarding personal contact. If people prefer not to hug or shake hands, please respect that. At this stage I have heard nothing about Holy Communion and the Common Cup so we will keep up our present practice with the cups. Directives still apply as to your coming to church regarding health, so if you are feeling unwell and exhibiting flu like symptoms, then please don't come and if need be go and get tested.

Do be aware these details do matter. If we do not comply with the directives there are legal and financial implications. The more we help one another, especially those on welcoming the better off we will all be.
