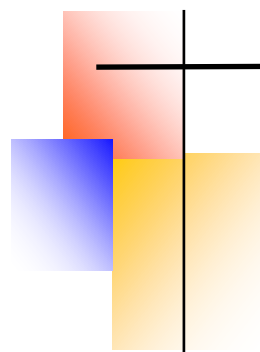

LORD HAVE MERCY!

There are times in our lives, in the lives of communities and nations where we experience exhaustion. I know, I'm tired, tired of the white noise that is COVID and so many bureaucratic measures placed upon me and my family by our leaders both political and ecclesiastical. We speak of one day resuming normal lives as they were pre-COVID yet even then many are tired and stressed.

In the morning service we look at the miracle of a blind man receiving sight, a miracle that comically exposes the blindness of Judah's religious leaders. Preoccupied with power and prestige they harass this innocent man blessed with sight by Jesus and his parents who just want to hide, all so they can 'expose' Jesus for the danger they think he is. I can only guess what it's like to live without the sense of sight but how many of us can be blind in other ways. We pray God will, by his Spirit, give us eyes to see the truth and live accordingly, to pray others will see the truth of Jesus and God's kingdom as well.

In the afternoon service we continue to look at the Lord's Prayer and the pray for God to give us our daily bread. Both versions in Matthew and Luke share the emphasis on praying for the daily bread we need TODAY! We need to learn from the past and be mindful of the future but we can only live in the present, today, praying God will provide all that we NEED today, physically, mentally, emotionally, relationally and spiritually.

I am tired in the middle of this hot summer but even in our tiredness, we pray for the light of the gospel to shine in the darkness we see around us and that hides within us and we pray in faith that whatever the challenges and circumstances we deal with, God will indeed today, give us our daily bread, mindful of many here and across the world for whom that is a substantial challenge and need.
