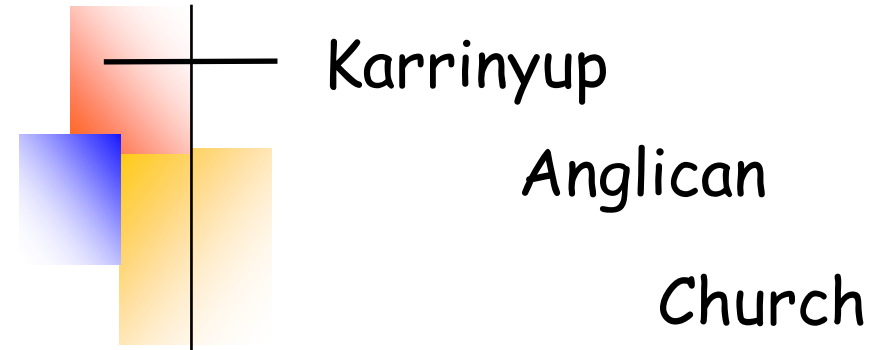

1 John and the Anointing

Over the years in some Christian quarters I've heard the term 'the anointing' used to describe a heightened state of faith or to describe someone which has a particularly dynamic ministry. In the New Testament the term only appears a few times, mostly in 1 John. So what does John mean when he writes of 'the anointing'?

In the Old Testament those who were anointed in Israel had a particular office that was Prophet, Priest or King. When we come to the New Testament those offices are fulfilled in the Lord Jesus, the very Word of God, our great high Priest and the everlasting Messiah, baptised when the Holy Spirit visibly came upon him.

1 John reminds us that when we place our faith in Jesus, God come in human flesh who died and rose from the dead, we too receive the anointing, that is God's Holy Spirit through whom we know God the Father and God the Son. We can certainly speak of particular individuals being gifted or filled by the Spirit but not anointed. That is to set up a two tier Christianity that the New Testament will not license.
