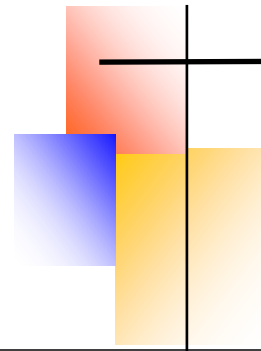

## POLITICAL EXPEDIENCY, DIVINE SOVREIGNTY

Human beings are remarkable and confounding creatures. We are capable of so much good and of majestic accomplishments whether in the Arts, science and industry or in our care for others and the world. We are also capable of monstrous evils such as war and violence, greed and ruthless self-interest and abuse and disregard for others and the world. We again see these things especially in and around Europe. We see governments rally to support a needlessly war-torn country and countries abstain from condemning or even support a regime in its evil intent. In south-east Queensland we see people rally to save lives while others take opportunity to rob and steal.

As we enter the season of Lent and continue to look at John's gospel and the lead up to the Cross, we see the responses to Jesus and his claims intensify and diversify. Today we see the religious leadership wrestle with what to do with him and the High Priest of the time suggests they try to see him executed by the Romans. Caiaphas, like Pilate, is a pragmatist but he is also afraid, not of God but of the Romans. The clamour around Jesus could foster revolution that leads to total military domination, a threat that is actualised 30 years later. We too live in a world where political expediency is often the rule of the day, but God is greater than all of these things and can providentially use them to accomplish his plans, even the salvation of the whole world.
