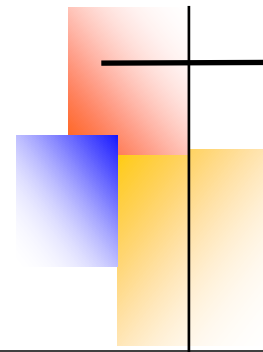

## SPIRITUAL COMPASSES

Over the next few weeks and months as I indicated at last week's AGM we need to seriously consider rethinking what we do as a church and why. It's providential that we are looking at the gospel of John of which witness is a major theme. To be Disciples of Christ means being a pointer to and for Christ in the way we speak, act and live.

We can be helpful witnesses or unhelpful witness. We witness to the gift of eternal life we have in our Lord Jesus Christ in the way we speak with one another and others, in the things that people see command our time and attention. We're witnesses in the way we deal with trials, temptations, struggles, illness, even with death. We're witnesses in the way we respond when things go well and we either mistakenly take the credit or give thanks and praise to God. We witness in the way we use our money, time and energy, in the gifts God gives us and in or attention to others.

Long ago the early church saw tremendous growth in the midst of disaster and trouble especially during plagues because of the way they lived and loved in the name of Christ. It's time to ask how we can be a powerful pointer in God's grace to Christ to the shopping centre over the road, to beachgoers, to our local suburb and beyond, to the young and old, powerful and powerless and to those God is calling without our realizing it. There are many challenges in all of this as well as opportunities but for too long churches take the easier option and wonder why little changes. It's time to pray, to consider, discuss and to act in the name and with the love of Christ.

- Registrations are open from Mondays to Saturdays before each Sunday service and no registrations can be made on the day of the service. We will keep a record of attendance to be safe.

#### COVID-19 UPDATE

1. Sunday services can still be accessed through our new Facebook page 'Karrinyup Anglican Church Services'. Request an invitation if you are on Facebook and Kevin can give you access. The sermons are still available in audio as well.
2. We can now have up to 100 people attend provided we keep 1.5 metres apart from each other aside from couples and families. The chairs will be spaced accordingly.
