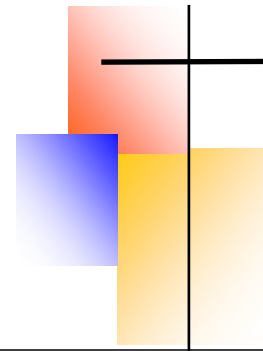

GOD WITH AND FOR US

Today we begin looking at the Lord Jesus in the Creeds. As we continue praying, the creeds remind us why we pray and that we can in Jesus' name and his name alone. In him we have boldness to approach God's throne with our requests and speak to him as our loving Father, the Father of the Son in whom we are children too.

As we think about Jesus though we keep in mind that his existence did not begin with that first Christmas. Jesus as the second person of the Trinity dwelt through eternity with the Father and the Spirit. There are those over the centuries who believe Jesus is the first created being. The creeds summarise the biblical view that this is false. Jesus is not just like God, he is God. The description of his being the only-begotten Son again reminds us that as we speak of God we use the language of analogy. All human beings require a mother and a father. They all have a beginning, a conception and then a birth. Though we use the language of begetting with regard to Jesus it must be understood in light of the bible otherwise we too can fall into the trap of seeing Jesus as a god, not God the Son.

These things matter because Christianity is a monotheistic faith that affirms the unity and transcendence of God over and above his creation. Jesus comes as the link between creator and creation, between the eternal God and the time constrained universe. It means he alone is the perfect mediator between God and humanity as he is both fully God and fully human. This is a great mystery that is suprarational. We can explain it but only to a point as we read the bible and consider the evidence but in the end we believe it or we do not. In believing it though the promise is we will have life in his name and all that is his will be ours. That is a grand hope in which we live.

COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- * Masks no longer mandatory while indoors at church but if you for any reason prefer to still wear one please do so. That is simply a matter of choice.
- * Hospitals and Residential aged care and disability care facilities -

 - two visitors per patient per day (except for compassionate reasons and essential visitors)
