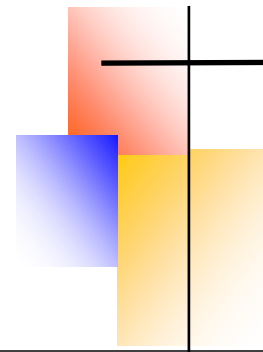

OH DEAR (aka HERE WE GO AGAIN)

Thank you to everyone here at KAC for your prayers as we took a break following beach mission. I was and still am looking forward to catching up with many of you this week but given the recent scare we will have to make some short-term changes for our services on the 7th (*we are unsure as to the 14th of February but hopeful) in light of the restrictions in place for that period. As I write this I have not received any communication formally from the Diocese but am basing the following on the Premier's comments from Thursday night's news conference. Unless I receive advice to the contrary (which we will let you know by email) the following procedure and requirements will be in place for this **Sunday 7th February** and we are unsure as to the *14th of February but provided there are no outbreaks we should be able to go back to as we were in pre-lock down. However, keep in mind that things are changing quickly so we will let you know as we find out.

- 1) Anyone coming will be required to register their attendance as has been the custom for the last couple of months via the app or sheet.
- 2) Anyone coming of high school age or older WILL BE required to wear a mask throughout the service. This is not optional. If you are not comfortable wearing a mask for any reason, don't come to church for the brief duration.
- 3) The seating will be rearranged to enable people to socially distance according to the 4m² rule. Only couples can sit together.
- 4) If you are feeling unwell for ANY reason, please stay home and not go outdoors.
- 5) Good hygiene will be practised prior and throughout the services.

The sermon at 9.30 will also be video and audio recorded, and the video posted on the Karrinyup Anglican Church Services Page.
