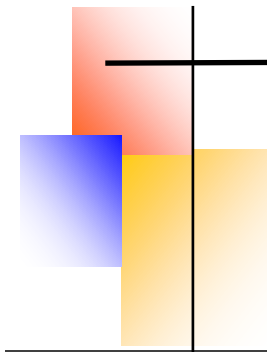

Old Church — New Life

7th June 2020

LOVE, LOADS, LEANING

This Sunday's passage is one that doesn't get quoted when we think of the letter to the Galatians. More often than not we think of last week's passage on the Fruit of the Spirit or our full equality in Christ in Gal 3:28 or some of Paul's more colourful retorts against his opponents. Nonetheless, today's passage has some profound consequences and is a great help for our relationships with each other.

Our culture is such where people are increasingly desperate for counsel and help on how to live and experience healthy relationships at a time when we see so many unhealthy ones. All too often relationships are grounded in coercion, manipulation, fear, anger, personal gain and the desire for control amongst others. Sadly relationships within the church are often little different or much better.

Paul fills out what our freedom in Christ and the call to love means. He once again shows us another and a better way where relationships are grounded in love, trust, grace and freedom, not fear, anger, selfishness and control. Paul's words here especially in verses 2 to 4 ought to shape how leadership is conducted and respected, how parents teach their children and how we work together in the cause of Christ amongst other things. In a world marked by one form of relational dysfunctionality after another such a church as this would be a wonder indeed!

- Registrations are open from Mondays to Saturdays before each Sunday service and no registrations can be made on the day of the service. We will keep a record of attendance to be safe.
- If you can't register online and you want to attend you can register through the church office 9341 5572 Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday before 12 noon only.

COVID-19 UPDATE

1. Sunday services can still be accessed through our new Facebook page 'Karrinyup Anglican Church Services'. Request an invitation if you are on Facebook and Kevin can give you access. The sermons are still available in audio as well.
2. We can now have up to 100 people attend provided we keep 1.5 metres apart from each other aside from couples and families. The chairs will be spaced accordingly. Communion will still be of one kind and good hygiene should be maintained before, during, between and after services. We will refrain from physical contact for the sharing of the Peace for the time being.
