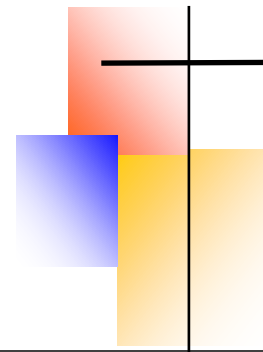

## GOD SPEAKS; ARE WE LISTENING?

Years ago comet McNaught appeared in the western sky and for those of us on the west coast a trip to the coast in the early evening provided a spectacular view of the comet. The next Sunday I preached from Psalm 19, a psalm that appeals to both the scientist and theologian within. The Psalm speaks of the twofold witness to God's glory in creation and in the scriptures. What is interesting as I consider this Psalm are the last few verses. Near the end David prays for God to keep him from sin and in particular two types of sin, from hidden sin and from presumptuous sin. For years I thought David was simply being pious, but I wonder if there is more to his prayer as we consider this two-fold witness to God's majesty and power.

Within theology we distinguish between Natural Revelation and Natural Theology. The latter is that attempt by people to make sense of God's natural revelation. David's prayer becomes important because sin innately causes us to distort that knowledge revealed around us into, at worst, idolatry. Natural Theology at best only gives us a god who is impersonal and remote or at worst we deify the forces and powers around us. Even today people look for the alternative primal explanation of the universe so that we can ignore the one, true God.

David's prayer at the end of the Psalm is also important because sin leads us to both unconsciously and presumptuously misinterpret God's word. It is his faithful and infallible word but our interpretations of it can be or are neither. As we read God's word, we need to continually pray his Spirit will illuminate our minds and hearts as it inspired his Word from the beginning. Both individually and together we pray for God's revelation to shape us rather than our trying to shape the bible for ourselves. In the days and months ahead this need will be vital for God's people.
