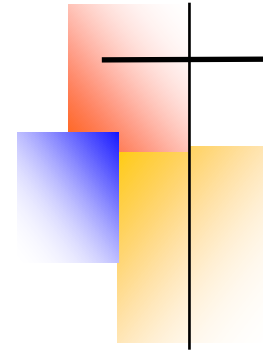

CHRISTIANS, POLITICS AND CHANGE

As we look at Acts 24-26 Paul finds himself enmeshed in Roman politics. The responses by Rome to his harassment and abuse are mixed, including rescue, neglect, indifference, bureaucracy, consideration and fear. We continue to see a variety of responses in the world today. Over the years I've realized the question of the Christian's and the church's relationship to politics is far from simple.

So how do we move forward? The New Testament writers give us a few fundamental pointers. Firstly we recognize the fundamental authority of the state, in whatever form it takes, to promote justice. Paul reminds us of this principle and that in promoting the common good; we have more opportunity to share the gospel. Secondly we are encouraged to pray for our leaders and politicians. Thirdly where appropriate we have a voice and should speak up individually and corporately for all that is good and just. Finally we look to the day when our Lord will return when justice will be established across the earth in every way, where we will live in peace with God and each other.
