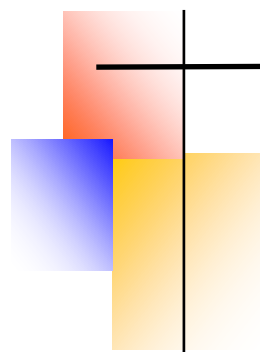

Making Changes

One of the few things we can be certain of in life is change. Change is constant as we live and grow and as time passes. Of course though we can speak of change and making changes at the level of our circumstances and behaviours. Change can be trivial or minor, changing the furniture or the route we take to work. Change can also be more substantial like moving house or very significant like a death in the family or relationship breakdown, a marriage or the birth of a child

Amos calls the people of Israel to change but here it is the change that we call repentance, changing one's mind, attitude and behaviour. Such change can and is often substantial and difficult. God calls for change for a couple of reasons. Firstly it's because we live our lives contrary to God's will and purposes, living lives marked by sin and the refusal to trust and serve God. Secondly God calls us to repentance because our conduct and behaviours whether in general or in a particular are hurtful, disruptive even destructive. Our actions have consequences that can bring about harm. By God's grace we recognise a pattern that only causes trouble that needs to change. In the long term our brokenness also serves to separate us from God and repentance is the means by which we are reconciled to him if we are willing.

In Amos' day repentance was a call back to covenant faithfulness and obedience to the Law of Moses. We though are reminded that as difficult as change can be when God puts his finger on an aspect of our life that needs to change that he helps us in the wonder of the Cross and the presence and power of his Spirit. We cannot truly change by ourselves, but his help is always there for those who want to sincerely make the changes. May God give us such strength as we daily die to sin and live to new life in Christ.
