LORD OF THE SABBATH

The phrase "the Lord of the Sabbath" is found in [Matthew 12:8](#), [Mark 2:28](#), and [Luke 6:5](#). In all three instances Jesus is referring to Himself as the Lord of the Sabbath or, as Mark records it, "The Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath" ([Mark 2:28](#)). In these verses, Jesus is proclaiming that He is the One who exercises authority even over the rules and regulations that govern the Sabbath day.

As such, Jesus was proclaiming to the world, especially to the legalistic Pharisees, that He was greater than the Law and above the laws of the Mosaic Covenant because, as God in flesh, He is the Author of those laws. Since the Lord of the Sabbath had come, He who is the only true "Sabbath rest" made the old law of the Sabbath no longer needed or binding. When He said, "The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath" ([Mark 2:27](#)), Jesus was attesting to the fact that, just as the Sabbath day was originally instituted to give man rest from his labours, so did He come to provide us rest from labouring to achieve our own salvation by our works. Because of His sacrifice on the cross, we can now forever cease labouring to attain God's favour and rest in His mercy and grace.

Church Matters

During last month was the 30th anniversary of the consecration of the KAC building. The real church at KAC began back in the early 1970s when the dioceses built the rectory on the plot of land next to the land that had been purchased for the church. A Sunday service was held each week in what is now Michael's Office (originally designed as a carport). A large turnout meant that the sliding doors into the rectory's lounge room were opened to allow for expansion. Eventually the congregation moved to worship at the Limelight Theatre in Morris Place and later the move was made to the Community Centre adjoining the Karrinyup Library. It was a gift of \$50 000 from St. Columba's Church in Scarborough that finally got the ball rolling on the building of KAC.
