Old Church — New Life

8th March 2020

A Dark Square

As we look at hints of Easter in some of the books of the Law (Genesis through to Deuteronomy) and as we see how they point us to the Lord Jesus and the Cross some of the events we are looking at will remind us the challenge the Cross presents to some of the darker aspects of human nature, of sin and how it often manifests itself in our lives.

Already we've seen and will see again the power and challenge of fear and of doubt. We will also see anger and the way the three manifest themselves in complaint and thanklessness. Behind all four though lies the deeper challenge of self-interest which is the heart of sin. I know best even over and above God. My life is MY life and no one or nothing will get in the way of the pursuit of my interests. We see this fundamentally in the pursuit of comfort, security and reputation. We want to be comfortable, safe and loved. All these things are good, but sin causes us to so focus at the expense of others or at any cost. The Israelites express it in their complaints against Moses and the Lord and in the desire to return to Egypt. All of a sudden slavery in a foreign land where they were treated like dirt doesn't seem so bad!!

Paul understands how it is that the Cross of Christ is the antidote to complaint and bitterness, terror and rage. It lies in the practice of thankfulness and contentment (Eph 5:15-21 Phil 4:10-13). When he is weak, Christ is strong. It is the Lord who redeems, provides and enables his disciples to live with and for him in the power of the Holy Spirit. His goal is to serve and proclaim the Lord trusting he will give him all he needs to accomplish that sacred task and grow in Christian maturity. We can do likewise.

Dear Friends, I had a good meeting with Archbishop Kaye just under a fortnight ago discussing some of my and our struggles with the Diocese over the last few years and months. We have just received correspondence from her and the Diocese that has directed \$10,000 to go against our debt to the Diocese to cover the back pay owed to Karen and Louisa. That portion of the debt has, in essence, been written off. We are now only just under three thousand dollars in debt to the Diocese. Praise God!
