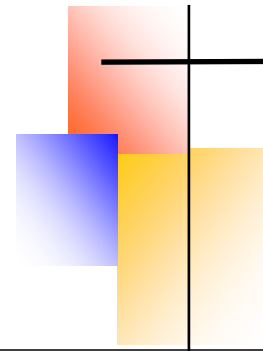

PLEASE PRAY!!!

One of the gifts God gives us is that of prayer. In prayer we pray for his will to be done on this earth and is working for the growth of his Kingdom in Christ. We are his partners in a way, his co-workers, in prayer as we look to him to work in the world. This weekend and next week please pray for the Australian Anglican Church. Over this next week the general synod of the Australian Anglican church will meet to discuss various matters. These will include discussions about marriage, human sexuality and in particular whether to and/or how to recognise same sex relationships.

It is no exaggeration to say this Synod is one of the most important Australian synods that has ever been held. The discussions will be controversial, passionate and potentially explosive. Given the trends that have occurred in the Americas, New Zealand and elsewhere this could make or break the Australian Anglican Church. I know that many through the church could have split over the Ordination of Women over 20 years ago, but such matters involved genuine differences amongst brothers and sisters in Christ. These discussions will have significant consequences for the Australian church as a whole and for every diocese including our own.

The outcome could have a significant effect on the motions that do or do not come to our own Synod later this year and make our choice of Synod representatives at the AGM a serious matter. My position and my relationships as a clergyperson in this Diocese will be seriously affected for good or ill as could our relationship with the Diocese, with other churches and with one another. At the heart are questions of what constitutes sin and thereby when and where we call people or not to repentance. There are views in our church that are ethically and theologically mutually exclusive, so the challenges are immense. Hence my passionate call, please pray. Contact me if you need to.

COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- * 2 sqm rule and 75% patron maximum capacity is removed
- * Masks no longer mandatory while indoors at church but if you for any reason prefer to still wear one please do so. That is simply a matter of choice.
- * Hospitals and Residential aged care and disability care facilities -
 - Masks must still be worn
 - two visitors per patient per day (except for compassionate reasons and essential visitors)
 - Visitors still required to show proof of vaccination
- * Practice good hygiene at all times, on entering the building and before taking communion especially
- * Be mindful during the greeting of the peace of other's preferences especially if they prefer not to make physical contact with others.
- * The collection at both services will happen by means of placing one's gift in the basket up front.
- * If anyone feels unwell or at risk, stay home and if need be get tested ASAP
- * Keep alert for state government requirements.
