A NOT SO TRIVIAL WITNESS?

When we think of the disciples whose names come to our minds. We usually think of Peter, James or John, of the betrayer Judas, or they consider the doubter Thomas, or Matthew. Often the focus is so much on Peter we forget he had a brother who was also a disciple, Andrew. Years ago my godmother bought me a birthday present that was a collection of sermons by Peter Marshall who had been a chaplain to the US congress. One sermon stuck in my mind as he noted that it is what Andrew does in John's gospel that stands out. In John 6 he is the one who brings a boy with bread and fish to Jesus to feed a crowd. In John 12 he brings some Greeks to see Jesus and in John 1 he brings Peter to meet the man he believes is the long-awaited Messiah. As we see Andrew's appearances in John are brief but noteworthy. Andrew is very good at simply bringing people to Jesus in seemingly trivial but crucial ways or moments.

Andrew serves as an example of the heart of mission and witness, that is to bring people to meet Jesus. He does so simply, enthusiastically and wholeheartedly. At no point does Andrew second guess his decision, nor does he feel the need to overcomplicate the matter. All he does is recognize, in his own way, that Jesus is someone very special and important and is happy to bring any and all to meet Jesus. He teaches us a salutary, straight forward and simple message. We don't have to explain everything and we won't have all the answers to people's questions. Nonetheless, we too like Andrew can pray for opportunity to bring the people around us to meet Jesus, the Jesus of the gospels and the Jesus who enlivens our hearts.

- Registrations are open from Mondays to Saturdays before each Sunday service and no registrations can be made on the day of the service. We will keep a record of attendance to be safe.

COVID-19 UPDATE

1. Sunday services can still be accessed through our new Facebook page 'Karrinyup Anglican Church Services'. Request an invitation if you are on Facebook and Kevin can give you access. The sermons are still available in audio as well.
2. We can now have up to 100 people attend provided we keep 1.5 metres apart from each other aside from couples and families. The chairs will be spaced accordingly. We will refrain from physical contact for the sharing of the Peace for the time being.
