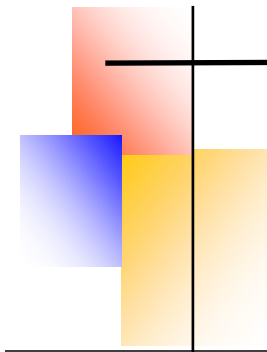

## Struggling Leaders, Fallen Leaders and Rebellious Leaders

It may be a startling truth for some but most of us know no leader is perfect, indeed most are far from it. We can find ourselves overwhelmed or unsure, slightly paranoid or a little too self-important. Leadership can bring out both the best and worst in people or they can find themselves falling prey to impossible expectations. We know some go the next step and fall prey to their fears or conceits, the weakness, failings and sins lead them off into unhelpful places. Thankfully by the grace of God we also know when that happens, the gift of God is repentance and people can come back.

The challenge here in Matthew 23 is that Jesus addresses leaders who are profoundly willful and stubborn. Through three symbolic acts and three parables Jesus has made it clear the Messiah has come to Jerusalem and those who reject him as such are in a truly dangerous place. Their three questions designed to little more than trap him only confirm the truth of Jesus' words. This is why he is so hard on them. They should have been the first to recognize and welcome him but instead they reject and despise him, to the point they plot his death. Jesus came to help, to bless and to save but their rejection of him will only bring judgment and condemnation.

Even today pray, not for perfect leaders but above all for faithful leaders, whose most fundamental motivation is Christ and following him in all they say and do, for leaders who are wise, focused and humble through whom the grace and power of God can and will work to change and transform.
