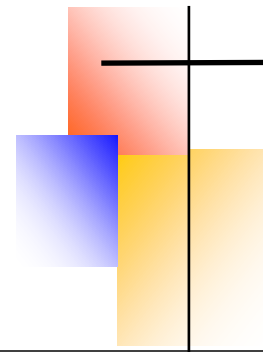

Resting Up

All of us enjoy a good break be it a long weekend, a holiday or long service leave or the equivalent. Rest is of course a biblical principle enshrined in the fourth commandment. Every gospel even recounts at least one miracle. It's not the miracle that the religious leaders find controversial as much as the fact the miracle was performed on the Sabbath. Such is the case with the miracle that was the third sign on John's gospel. Jesus shows us that the Sabbath, a day of rest is both the simple act of stopping and taking a break from work and celebrating the new life and one day the new age we have in Jesus Christ.

In recent times we implicitly learnt to reappraise the principle of rest when the country went into lockdown last year. So many people here in Australia appreciated simply stopping or slowing down, enjoying the company of others especially family, of not running around like headless chooks and enjoying the lovely world God has made. The western world has all but lost sight of the principle of a day, of periods of rest. The forces of materialism, capitalism and technological change have pushed us to work longer and harder in the name of productivity. Even when we stop working, our devices stay switched on each and every day all but commanding our devotion and attention.

Enjoying a day of rest means taking time to stop, to worship God with his people, to catch one's breath and to celebrate and enjoy the life God has given us in the here and now and to enjoy the new life of salvation and restoration we have in Christ. For some of us, including myself, it means saying no to our mobile phones, computers and games machines. We don't want to fall into the legalism of the religious leaders, but it would do us good to switch off literally and metaphorically and look to God.
