Jesus and Jonah

Today's passage from Matthew recounts that episode where the leaders ask a sign of Jesus and he refuses, offering only the sign of Jonah. At first glance the link between the two is the three days and nights Jonah spent in the whale and Jesus spent in the empty tomb. When you look at the story of Jonah though I think there is a little more to it.

The book of Jonah presents us with a man struggling with an internal dilemma. On the one hand he is a Jew, benefitting from the grace God had shown to his people over the centuries, part of God's chosen people, rescued from a hostile nation. Now that same God calls him to speak not to fellow Jews but to pagan Ninevites, calling them to repent or be destroyed. By the end of the short book we see it is too much for Jonah, especially when the people of Nineveh listen to his message and DO repent.

I think Jesus used him to remind the religious leaders of the self-righteousness that marked both them and Jonah and of the fact that in the gospels the people who were often first to believe Jesus were gentiles. They remind us of the danger of presuming upon grace and falling into such cold, disparaging self-righteousness, looking at others with disdain rather than grace and faith.
